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Anchor New “Mounting Trouble Signs” Brochure Now Available

Anchor Industries is pleased to introduce our new “Mounting Trouble Signs” brochure which provides practical tips for determining driveline mount failure signs and the proper diagnosis.

This four page brochure lists the probable causes and related vehicle problems that are most often affected. For example, a worn engine mount can crack or separate from the steel plate and cause noticeable engine vibration which can cause an accelerator or transmission linkage to bind and stick.

Quite often the OE hydraulic engine mount will leak hydraulic fluid causing the mount to sag and cause misalignment with other vehicle components.



Note: As little as a 1/4” misalignment from a sagging driveline mount can cause the CV joint to be off line by 1” or more, adding to the stress of the drive train.

A severely loose or broken mount will put added stress on exhaust manifolds and damage the exhaust doughnut or pipes. A broken mount can cause the engine to severely rock back and forth which can cause driveline belts and hoses to break and/or snap.



We also provide a “Quick Check Diagnosis” - Two Person Test:

Have an assistant start the engine and apply the parking brake. While still applying the brakes, put the transmission in gear (drive) and slightly increase the engine throttle. A severely worn or broken mount will cause excessive engine movement, sometimes as much as several inches if the engine lifts off the mount. Next, check the mounts on the other side of the engine. Once again have an assistant start the engine and apply the parking brake. While still applying the brakes, put the transmission in reverse, and slightly increase the engine throttle. Look for excessive engine movement on the other side.

The “Mounting Trouble Signs” brochure is an excellent informational/selling tool for any sales or counter person, because it lists several related vehicle problems that can be associated with driveline mount problems. The benefit is you can properly determine and fix the problem, not just the symptom while selling more parts!
